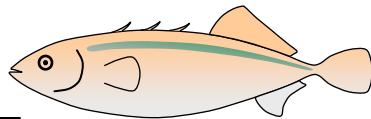
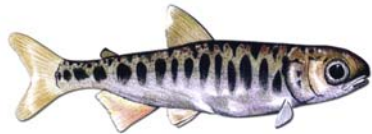

Put a check when you find each species in the touch tank, and circle the name if you or a friend can touch it.

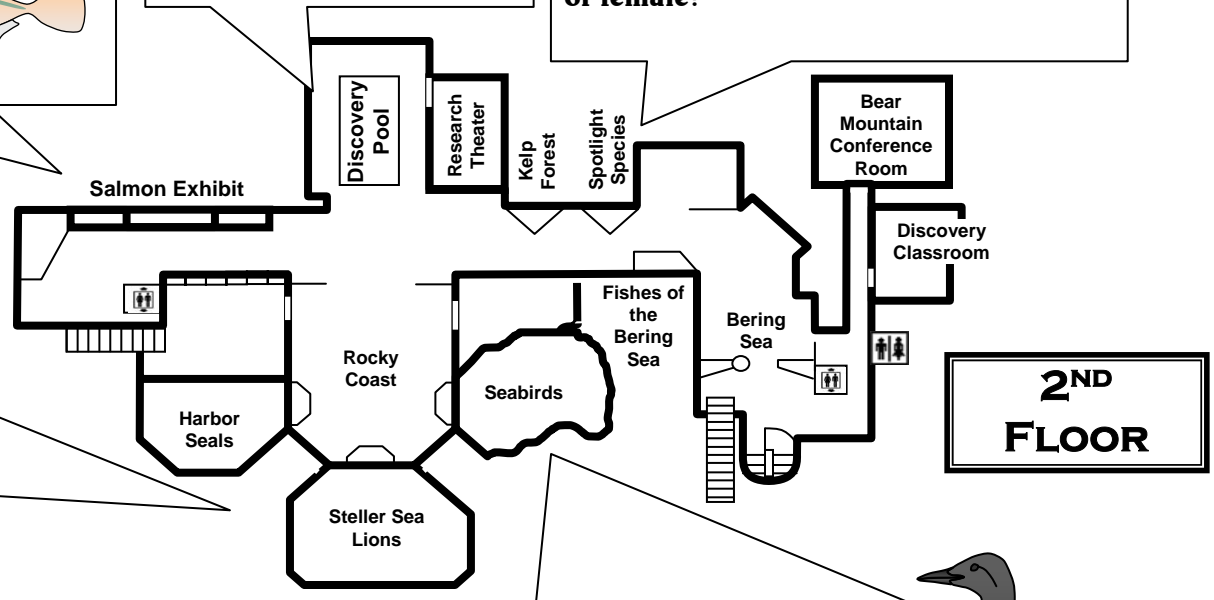
- Sunflower Star

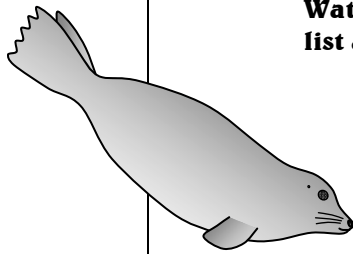
