Exhibits Technician

This position is responsible for assisting with developing and producing materials that interpret ongoing research and support the educational outreach program at the Alaska SeaLife Center.

Responsibilities (include but are not limited to):

- Produces printed materials such as brochures, fliers, posters, etc.
- Assist with the design, fabrication, and installation of exhibits, exhibit graphics, and informational and educational signage.
- Researches, develops, and writes informational and educational signage.
- Prepares images and illustrations for exhibits, posters, and publications.
- Lays out exhibit graphics with graphic editing software such as Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator.
- Prints and finishes graphic panels.
- Assists with improvements or replacement of existing signage as needed.
- Prepares three-dimensional props and interactive elements.
- Utilizes digital video and still camera equipment to capture various ASLC activities to be used as elements in exhibits or video based products.
- Interacts with husbandry and research personnel.

Requirements:

Associate's degree in art, natural sciences, graphic design, museum studies, or a related field and one year experience producing exhibit graphics and/or multimedia educational material in a public exhibit setting; or high school diploma and two years experience producing exhibit graphics and/or multimedia educational material in a public exhibit setting. Knowledge of Adobe In-Design, Adobe Photoshop and Adobe Illustrator. Knowledge of digital photography and video editing. Excellent written and verbal communication skills. Ability to take direction and work independently.
