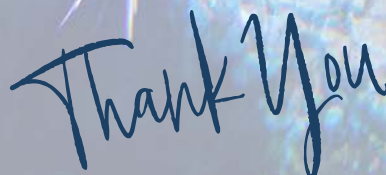

The Wildlife Response Program had a busy year. We rescued, rehabilitated, and released three harbor seals and one elephant seal during the 2022 season.

Additionally, the program cared for a black-footed albatross. One stranded sea otter pup was admitted. After recovering and getting a clean bill of health, he was transported to Shedd Aquarium.

ICE SEAL RESEARCH

The PHOCAS program (Physiology and Health of Cooperating Arctic Seals)—a research partnership between the Alaska SeaLife Center and the University of California Santa Cruz—continues to advance understanding of the elusive ice seals. In their most recent peer-reviewed publication, the team shared their findings from a decade-long effort to record and document spotted seal vocal behavior.

DIVERSITY, EQUITY, ACCESS, INCLUSION

ASLC launched a DEAI (Diversity, Equity, Access, and Inclusion) initiative to ensure that everyone can fully participate in our education, science, and conservation programs. As the first KultureCity Certified Sensory Inclusive Venue in Alaska, the facility is more accessible to those with sensory disabilities. By providing scholarships to participants, we ensure that income is not a barrier to participating. Our newly implemented DEAI Staff Council also provides a mechanism for employees to help shape a more inclusive work place.



CORaL NETWORK

The Alaska SeaLife Center is excited to be part of the CORaL (Community Organized Restoration and Learning) Network.

This ambitious collaboration between six organizations (Alaska SeaLife Center, Alaska Sea Grant, Alutiiq Museum and Archaeological Repository, Center for Alaskan Coastal Studies, Chugach Regional Resources Commission, and Prince William Sound Science Center) works to ensure that scientific information, skills, and activities are publicly accessible and serve ongoing needs as identified by local communities in the *Exxon Valdez* oil spill impacted region. The *Exxon Valdez* Oil Spill Trustee Council has generously provided \$12.5 million dollars to fund the 5-year launch of this project.



STELLER'S EIDERS IN THE AVIARY

Chosen out of the ASLC's flock for their easygoing disposition, juvenile Steller's eiders Prince (male) and Bowie (female) were introduced to the aviary in December 2022 and quickly adjusted to their new habitat and neighbors. Roughly the same size and with matching juvenile plumage, the two were virtually identical in appearance upon debut. This is the first time Steller's eiders have been in the public aviary at the Center, and now guests can see these unique Alaskan sea ducks when they visit.

ASSOCIATION OF ZOOS & AQUARIUMS

The Alaska SeaLife Center once again received accreditation by the Association of Zoos & Aquariums (AZA) independent Accreditation Commission in September of 2022. Accreditation inspectors were impressed with how the Center's high standards of animal care, research, and education not only met but frequently far exceeded AZA's requirements. The ASLC was first accredited by the AZA in 2011.

Seward Seabird Festival **June 10 - 12**

The Seward Seabird Festival returned in 2022. Participants gathered in Seward for a weekend-long event celebrating the migration of Alaska's seabirds through education, science, and art. There were free activities for all ages, including a seabird waterfront walk with the National Park Service, a puffin art workshop, a chat with seabird researchers, crafts, storytime, a puffling parade for kids, and seabird trivia at Seward Alehouse.



Plastic Free July **July 1 - 31**

Plastic Free July is a great time to reduce single-use plastic and join the movement to protect the ocean. On Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays in July, guests could hear special conservation chats from ASLC staff and enjoy kids' activities, a resource area, and a selfie station. Community members and staff joined together to help keep plastic out of Resurrection Bay by having two beach cleanups. ASLC staff provided educational resources to learn how to reduce plastic consumption, prizes, and more.



RoundUp for Research August 21 - 27

RoundUp for Research was a week-long fundraising event held in August on the Alaska SeaLife Center's social media pages. 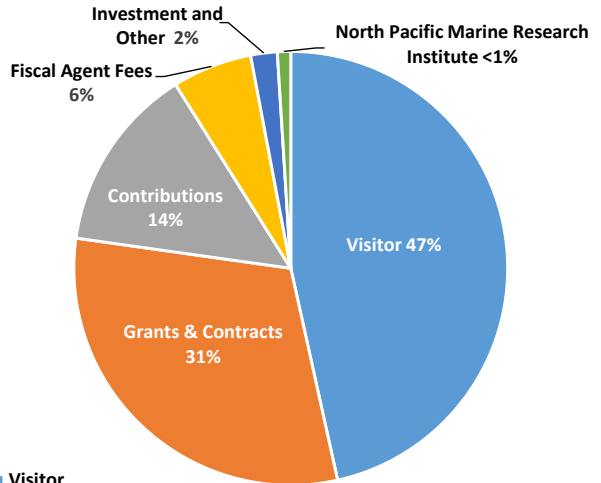

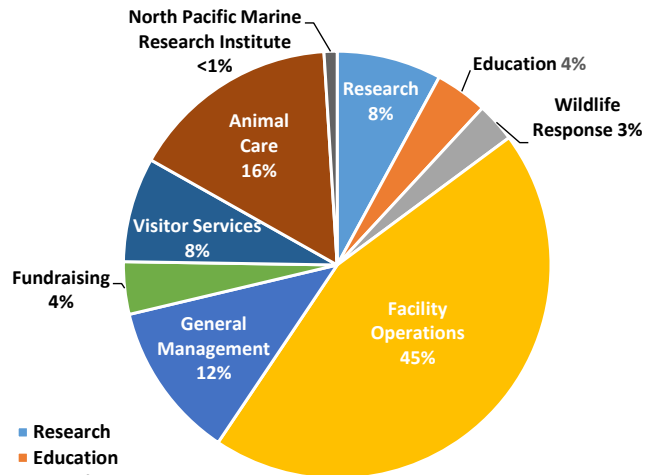
